

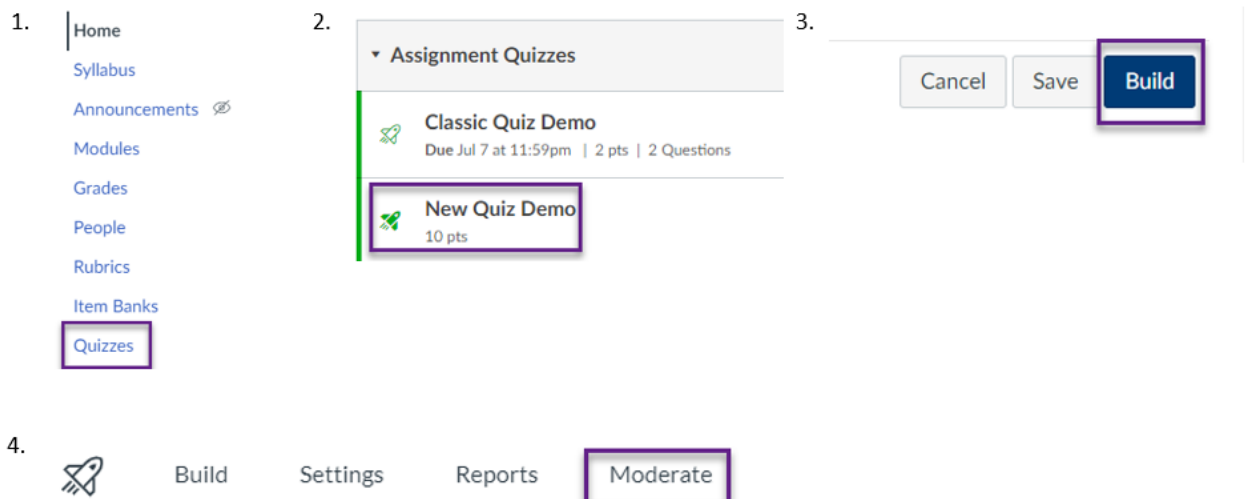
Moderating Quizzes in Canvas

When creating quizzes in Canvas, you are given two options- [New Quizzes](#) or [Classic Quizzes](#). Canvas will remove the Classic Quizzes feature from Canvas in August of 2022. We recommend creating your assessments using the New Quizzes feature. If you have migrated a quiz from Blackboard, this quiz will default to a Classic Quiz.

New Quizzes

New quizzes allow you set accommodations that will follow the student throughout your Canvas class. To set these, you will:

1. Open Quizzes
2. Select the assessment
3. Select “Build”
4. Navigate to the “Moderate” tab
5. Scroll to the learner and click “Moderate”
6. From the pop-up menu you can-
 - a. Adjust the number of attempts
 - b. Remove the time limit
 - c. Give additional time
 - d. Reopen a completed attempt



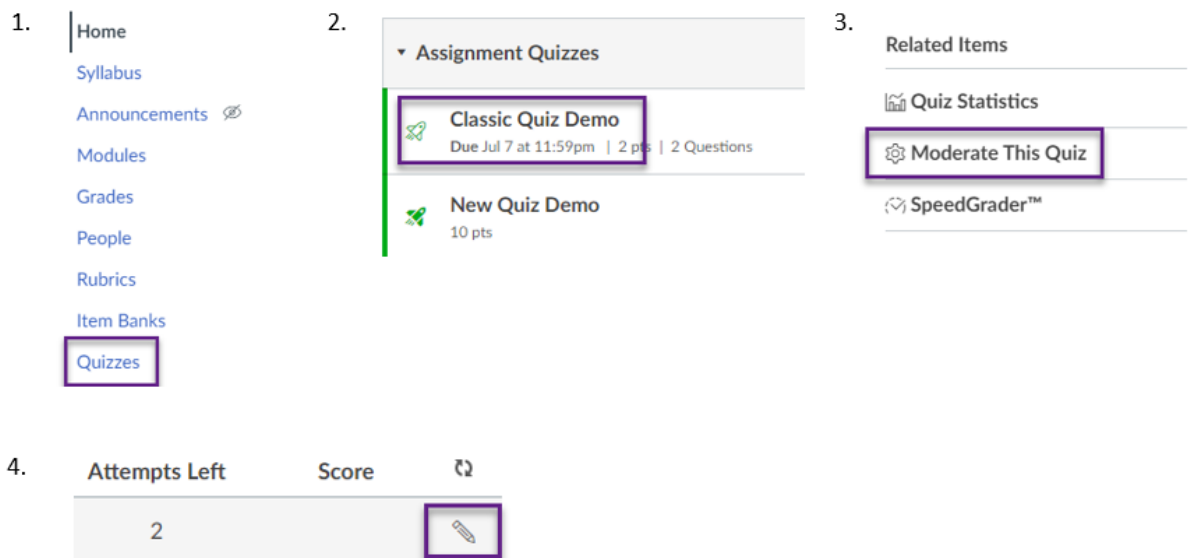
The screenshot illustrates the steps to moderate a quiz in Canvas:

Classic Quizzes

Accommodations set in classic quizzes will only impact the selected quiz. Accommodations must be set for each individual quiz. To set these, you will:

1. Open Quizzes
2. Select the assessment
3. Select “Moderate This Quiz” from the right-hand menu
4. Scroll to the learner and click the pencil on the far right of the screen.
5. From the pop-up you can-
 - a. Adjust the number of attempts
 - b. Add extra time on every attempt
 - c. Manually unlock the quiz for the next attempt
